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**Learning Agreement for Incoming Mobility Pupils Applying to Study
at Liceo-Ginnasio Statale *Virgilio* – Roma, Italy**

Aims

Liceo-Ginnasio Statale “Virgilio” welcomes pupils from other countries, both in Europe and overseas, in order to create an open environment for new friendships, foster mutual understanding and stimulate the respect for diverse cultural values. We are also convinced that personal contacts may improve the quality of our education.

Principles

Pupils on incoming mobility programmes who intend to study at Liceo Virgilio must be able to speak and understand Italian at least at an elementary level and undersign their commitment to attend a course of Italian in order to improve their linguistic competence.

Pupils on incoming mobility programmes are required to pay an enrolment fee of €300, corresponding to the facilities and services offered by the school, including a ten-hour course of Italian as a second language and any free extra-curricular courses.

A foreign pupil will be admitted to the form/class group corresponding to his/her age and to the course of studies chosen, provided he/she has the knowledge and competencies necessary to be able to interact at least in the classes concerning the main target subjects of that course. Otherwise, the school advisors will themselves decide which course of studies is the most appropriate to the student’s basic preparation. In any case, foreign students are required to hand in certificates and/or reports from their sending institution or home country, certifying the contents and level of competence of the same subjects as those taught at Liceo Virgilio.

The attendance of curricular classes must be regular. Absence or late coming to lessons will be recorded and has to be justified. No certification will be issued if absences amount to more than 25% of the total number of curricular classes.

Foreign pupils must be well-behaved and succeed in their studies.

During their attendance at Liceo Virgilio, pupils will follow all the activities of the class group they join, and do all the assignments given by the teachers as much as it is possible to them.
